

Heat Pump Rebates

Rebates vary by state, by type of heating fuel you currently use, and by the type of heat pump you install.

Whole-Home Air-Source Heat Pump Pilot (MassCEC)

Income Category	Incentive per Residence
>120% of state median income	\$2,500
80%-120% of state median income	\$3,750
<80% of state median income	\$5,000

The Massachusetts Clean Energy Center ("MassCEC") provides rebates for the installation of whole-home air-source heat pumps in existing gas-heated homes or new construction. These systems must be designed to meet 100% of your heating needs. May be combined with Mass Save rebates.

**For homes in Mass Save communities regardless of heating fuel
(not including areas served by municipal light and power plants)**
